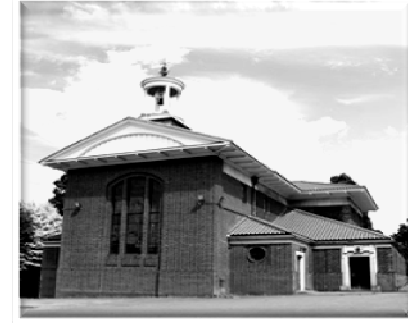

St Mary's Church is located within the grounds of Knebworth House in Old Knebworth. Regular services at St. Mary's use the Book of Common Prayer, used in this church for hundreds of years, and appeal to those who value the traditions of the Church of England, which are part of our national heritage.

St Martin's Church is located in the centre of (new) Knebworth on the corner of St Martin's Road and London Road.

Our Worship

8 am Holy Communion

(St Mary's and St Martin's on alternate Sundays)

St. Mary's on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays in the month, St. Martin's on the 2nd and 4th Sundays. These are said services. The service at St Mary's uses the traditional Book of Common Prayer; that at St Martin's uses the Common Worship Form 1.

10 am Holy Communion and Family Communion

(St Martin's)

On the 1st and 3rd Sundays in the month, it follows the Common Worship form with music on the organ. On the 2nd Sunday the service is less formal. It remains based on Common Worship, but includes modern worship songs provided by the music group, Celebration, and with the organ. Celebration commence playing at 9.45 am and the congregation are encouraged to join in the singing before the start of the service.

All age services

On the 4th Sundays an all age service is held at St Martin's commencing at 10 am with music by Celebration from 9.45 am. On occasions an all age service is held at St Mary's with the organ.

6 pm Evensong (St Mary's)

This service (the office of Evening Prayer of the Church of England) takes place on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month using the Prayer Book with traditional hymns (Hymns Ancient and Modern) accompanied by the organ.

Thursday Holy Communion

Each Thursday at 10 am at St Martin's church a Holy Communion service takes place. This service is linked with the St Mary's and St Martin's branch of the Mothers' Union on the 4th Thursday but anyone is most welcome to attend.
