



ST MARY'S AND ST MARTIN'S PARISH CENTRE

Knebworth Parish Centre was built in the 1990's to complement the architecture of St Martin's church, its purpose being to serve the whole community as well as the church.

The building contains the main hall, the committee room (to the left as you enter) and upstairs, the Elsie Martin room and the church office (which is shared with the Churches Together in Stevenage organisation). It also has a well equipped kitchen which is available to anyone hiring the hall, together with toilet facilities for both able and disabled users.

On Sunday mornings, it is home to Junior church (in the main hall) and the youth group, I.C.O.N. (upstairs in the Elsie Martin room). After the 10am service, many of the congregation gather in the Centre for coffee and a chat. The church also holds most of its meetings in the centre and it is often used for fundraising events e.g. quizzes, mini markets, special dining evenings.

The Centre is also in frequent use by the wider community, with regular classes for exercise (of various types and aimed at various age groups), children's dance classes, a slimming club and a mums and toddlers group. The hall is extremely popular for children's birthday parties and many village organisations hire the facilities for meetings and events.

The Centre is managed by a committee of volunteers, drawn from the congregation, who take care of the day to day running of the building on behalf of the P.C.C.
